## Official Rules

### LOCATION FOR REGISTRATION, CHECK-IN AND COOK-OFF JUDGING

- Auction building (corner of Walnut Street and Baylor Street)

### CONTESTANTS

- Check in begins at 2:00 pm on Thursday, September 19, 2024
- All cook sites will be available on a first come, first serve basis
- Product containers will be passed out at the time of registration

### COOKED ON SITE

- All categories must be cooked and prepped on the cooking site
- All contest meat will be inspected on Friday, September 20, 2024
  - All raw meat will be brought to the site
  - Meat may not be removed from the cook site after it has been inspected
- Steaks will be handed out on Friday evening at 6:00 pm
- DO NOT put ashes in dumpsters or dump on ground
- Water access located at the Auction building

### COOKS MEETING

- **Mandatory Cooks Meeting** will be held at 4:00 pm Friday, September 20, 2024, at the Auction building, at the corner of Walnut Street and Baylor Streets.

### SAFETY REQUIREMENT

- Cooks are to prepare and cook barbeque in a sanitary manner
- No dug pits will be allowed
- Precautions must be made to prevent fire threat
- Beans and salsa can be cooked with gas or electric appliances

## SAUCE/GARNISHING

- **Meat entries**
  - You may cook with sauce, however when preparing meat for turn-in, nothing may be added to the meat in the tray. No garnishing of any kind will be allowed in the meat trays.
- **Bean entry**
  - Start at the site from dry pinto beans
  - Must fit in provided styrofoam cup with lid
  - Fill the designated cup to within one (1) inch of the top of cup with juice that almost covers beans
  - Nothing is to be included in the bean cup larger than a bean
  - You may cook with condiments, veggies and/or meat and spices, however when turning in your beans, there is to be nothing in the cup larger than a bean
- **Drink & Salsa entries**
  - Must fit in provided styrofoam cup with lid
  - No pico de gallo in salsa
  - No garnishing (i.e. limes, jalapenos, pickles, etc.) will be allowed in drinks

## FOOD/DRINK CATEGORIES

- Categories will be judged on Friday and Saturday
- Categories must be delivered to the designated turn-in point in their designated containers with aluminum foil (received during registration)
  - No aluminum foil substitutes will be accepted
  - Meat is to be placed on the foil for turn-in
  - Do not fold foil over meat or mark the foil in any manner
- Styrofoam cups will be provided for beans, salsa and drinks.
- Each cook presenting an entry must sign the back of the ticket on each container
  - The cook is responsible for their signed ticket and keeping it in a safe place
- Signed ticket must be presented to claim any prize announced at the award ceremony

## AWARD CEREMONY

- Saturday, September 21, 2024, at 5:15 pm
  - If there is a tie, the prize money will be split between the high point winners

## HIGH POINT COOKER

- The cooker/team who receives the highest points from the awards that he/she has won will win **\$3000.00** and a plaque. To qualify for highpoint cooker, you must enter all categories.

Points will be tabulated as follows on all categories entered:
